About the Racetrack Run

The Racetrack Run is an endurance challenge with the goal of visiting every major racetrack in the UK in four days. If you are looking for a race or a track-day, please look elsewhere. It is, however, a great challenge and will be great fun whether you are a motor-racing enthusiast or simply want to support a great charity.

The Awards

In the spirit of making sure that nobody tries to make a race of it, the awards are thoroughly inexpensive, but there will be prizes available for such things as best dressed car, car the judge would most like to go home in and of course biggest bug splat. A full list of rules will be given to each participant prior to the start date.

The Cost

Entry is £185 per person. This includes accommodation, breakfast at Goodwood and dinner near Silverstone. We then ask that you raise in sponsorship £500 per car for the Charity.

We will provide you with an online fundraising page. You can send this link to anyone who you think might sponsor you. People will want to support you, as it is a great thing you are doing for charity and many people are surprised to see that they can raise in excess of the target by doing this alone.

Accommodation

You are likely to be spending very little time in your room and so the standard is basic in most of the hotels. Again upgrades are available, but at an additional cost.

About the Charity

The Children's Respite Trust is a charity that truly believes no family should be left to care for a disabled child alone and so we provide respite, both at our Respite Centre in Uckfield, Sussex and through community care across East Sussex and Kent.



Respite means giving families a chance to do things that the rest of us take for granted. It can be as basic as an opportunity to do household chores or simply get a rest, but much of the time it is a chance for the siblings of the disabled children to receive some much-needed attention.

Respite is also a break for the children themselves. When so much of their time is spent having their "needs managed", it is vital that we ensure that their time with us filled with stimulation, enjoyment and fun. That's why our Respite Centre has been designed to be a warm, welcoming and homely place with, soft play, sensory facilities, an arts and crafts area and teenage lounge.



In 2022 we need to raise £1¼m to continue to provide this valuable care for families across Sussex and parts of Surrey and Kent. That's a huge task, especially as we come out of a pandemic and haven't been able to hold any fundraising events for a year. Therefore, any support that we receive comes as a huge boost.
